January 7, 2018

A Christmas letter was received from Al and Dellene Stucky, retired missionaries of Wycliffe Bible Translators living in Ephrata, WA.

“Have you ever wondered why God would want human beings here on this earth to be a part of His redemption plan? Why would He give each one of us the work of giving this good news to others? I guess we don’t need to know these answers as long as we trust Him. He is so much bigger than we can even imagine and it is so good to know that He loves us.

“Willow Drive Nursery which is just across the road from us has been harvesting their apple trees to sell. There has been so much activity there with bringing in the small trees from the fields, and then grading them to sell. Mark who worked there for about 35 years came back in October from Arizona and helped with the harvest for 3 weeks. It was so good to have both Mark and Cyndi stay with us, although she was here for only one week. They moved to Arizona two years ago.

“We just heard from Marlyn and Lynda. Marlyn had back surgery in Singapore in the spring. He is doing well although he still has some nerve pain in his leg. He has been busy teaching different groups there in Ukarumpa. Most of their finances went to pay off his medical bills so they haven’t traveled too much. They have planted a big garden and are teaching the children.

“David and son Jonathan are renting a house here close by so we see them often. Michal works in Austin, TX, and Brendon and Tabitha moved to Georgia which is closer to her family. Kacia is living in Omaha where she graduated in June and has been student teaching. It was so great that Michelle and I could be there for her graduation.

“God has been so good to us. He has provided for our needs, given us work to do, and given us family close by. We don’t hear much from Papua New Guinea but are trusting God is still bringing forth fruit from His Word. This Christmas season we wish you God’s special blessing. We want to thank you so much for your gifts to us for so many years. May God bless you and give you a wonderful year ahead.”
